



As a prospective patient of Lakeside Women's Hospital, we are pleased to inform you of the following:

DISCLOSURE OF PHYSICIAN OWNERSHIP

- 1. Lakeside Women's Hospital (the "Hospital") is partly owned by physicians and meets the federal definition of a physician owned hospital as specified in 42 CFR 489.3. Hospital's physician owners include: Susan Chambers, MD; Valerie Engelbrecht, MD; Margaret Hall, MD; Deborah Huff, MD; Laura Mackie, MD; Jennifer Nelson, MD; Dana Stone, MD; Virginia Vaughan, MD; Lisa Wasemiller-Smith, MD; Chris Davis, MD; Jennifer McNeil, MD; and William Miller, MD
- 2. You have the right to choose the provider of your health care services. Therefore, you have the option to use a health care facility other than Lakeside Women's Hospital.
- 3. You will not be treated differently by your physician if you choose to use a different facility. If desired, your physician can provide information about alternative providers.

DISCLOSURE OF EMERGENCY RESPONSE PLAN

- 1. Lakeside Women's Hospital has arranged for one or more physicians to be on-site at the Hospital and available to respond to medical emergencies during most hours of operation. However, we cannot guarantee that a physician will be present at the Hospital at all times. The Hospital has taken certain measures to ensure that qualified and properly trained medical personnel are available to respond to any medical emergency that may arise when a physician is not present at the Hospital.
- 2. In the event a patient experiences a condition that could be considered an emergency medical condition, the registered nurse will evaluate the patient and render care within the scope of her licensure. A hospital representative will, at the same time, contact the patient's treating physician, who under Hospital policy, is responsible for the care of his or her patient while the patient is undergoing treatment at the Hospital.

The treating physician, upon being contacted, will issue orders and, if necessary, come to the Hospital to further evaluate and treat the patient. The Hospital nursing staff will implement the treating physician's orders. If necessary, the treating physician will order the patient's transfer to another hospital that provides additional emergency services.

Registered nurses are certified in advance cardiac life support. In addition, the Hospital has a crash cart on each unit and also has telemetry and ventilator equipment available for use. The Hospital also maintains an on-call surgical services support team in the event that unscheduled surgery is required.
